

SERVICE AGREEMENT


This Agreement is made on this 15th day of March, 2017 by and between the Italian Cultural Institute, located at the Chancery of the Embassy of Italy in Washington, DC, at 3000 Whitehaven Street NW, Washington, DC 20008, represented by Amb. Armando Varricchio, Director ad interim, hereinafter called the Institute, and Design Cuisine, located at 2659 South Shirlington Road, Arlington, VA 22206, represented by Kent Smith, Account Executive, hereinafter called the Contractor.

Whereas

the Institute is co-presenting, in collaboration with the Embassy of Italy, the concert "In Dreams Awake", on the occasion of the 60th anniversary of the Treaties of Rome (the "Event"), which will take place on March 22, 2017 at the Chancery of the Embassy of Italy, located at 3000 Whitehaven Street NW, Washington, DC 20008 (the Premises), and accepts the Contractor's proposal submitted on March 13, 2017 (the Proposal), which constitutes integral part of this Agreement.


The two Parties to this Agreement, as represented above, agree to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) The Contractor shall render the following services (the Service):
 - 1.1) Lease of 200 chairs mod. Chiavari Mahogany, and 200 chairs mod. Chiavari Regency;
 - 1.2) delivery to the Premises and set up of 400 leased chairs on 3/22/2017 at 10:00 am;
 - 1.3) removal of the 400 leased chairs on 3/23/2017 at 10:00 am.
- 2) The Institute shall correspond the gross sum of \$2,600.00 (two thousand six hundred US dollars and 0 cents) as comprehensive compensation for the Service referenced in article 1 (the Fee). The payment of the Fee shall be made by bank check or bank transfer payable to Design Cuisine, following the successful completion of the Service and upon receipt of the relevant invoice.
- 3) The Contractor commits to the fulfillment of any and all tax obligations that may result from the above payment.
- 4) The Contractor shall be responsible for all accidents and damages caused to the Contractor's personnel and/or third persons or things imputable to the execution of the Service.
- 5) The non execution of the Service under this contract due to force majeure recognized by the laws and customs will not constitute breach of contract.



- 6) In case of any dispute arising from this Agreement, the Parties agree to resort to legal action only after all attempts to reach an amicable resolution have been exhausted.
- 7) This Agreement does not constitute an employment agreement between the two Parties.
- 8) This Agreement cannot be automatically renewed.
- 9) The Institute preserve the rights to rescind this agreement by simple written notification to the Contractor with no obligation to pay the Fee in the following cases:
 - failure of the Contractor to comply with the terms of this Agreement;
 - evident negligence of the Contractor in the execution of the Service.
- 10) The Contractor gives consent to the processing of the information contained in this Agreement in accordance with the law on transparency in the Italian Public Administration (Legislative Decree 33/2013). The Contractor consents to the processing of personal information, pursuant to Legislative Decree 196/2003, for the purposes related to the execution of this agreement.
- 11) The Parties agree to the processing of personal information in compliance with the laws on the right to privacy.
- 12) This Agreement drafted in 2 (two) originals is signed by the parties.
